INTERdistrict Transfers – RENEWALS ONLY!

INTERdistrict transfer request applications are for students who live OUTSIDE CUSD boundaries and wish to attend CUSD schools. **Effective with the 2009-2010 school year, applications will only be accepted for INTERdistrict transfer students who are currently attending CUSD schools. No new applications will be accepted, including applications for siblings of current students.** Approval for continuing students will be contingent upon meeting the obligations as outlined in the application: satisfactory attendance, scholarship and citizenship.

INTRAdistrict Transfers

INTRAdistrict Transfer Request Applications are for those students who live INSIDE the CUSD boundaries wishing to attend a school other than their assigned neighborhood school. Schools accepting INTRAdistrict Transfer Request Applications (grades 1-8 only) for the 2009-2010 school year are as follows:

***Jefferson Elementary School (K-5)**

*** Jefferson Elementary School will be accepting INTRAdistrict transfer applications (grades K-5) for their International Baccalaureate Primary Years Program during the open enrollment period.** Jefferson will be the only school accepting kindergarten applications at this time. All other schools will accept kindergarten applications following Kindergarten Roundup in May.

***Applications for the IB Program at Jefferson Elementary are on a “first-come” basis; therefore they will only be accepted at Jefferson Elementary School. All other applications will be accepted at the District Office and school sites during regular business hours. Applicants will be notified no later than May 15, 2009.**

PLEASE NOTE: Applications are required annually for any student not attending their neighborhood school. Once accepted, enrollment at the requested site is considered binding for a period of one year.
